This is to inform you that Department of Innovation, Science and Economic
Development (ISED) Canada has received confirmation that

QAI Laboratories, Ltd
CAB Identifier: CA9543

has been recognized by **IMDA (Info-communications Media Development Authority)**
in Singapore to perform equipment testing using:

**IDA TS SRD, IDA TS AR, IDA TS WBA,
IDA TS LMR, IDA TS CBS, IDS TS UWB, IDA TS GMPCS**

under Phase I of the APEC TEL Mutual Recognition Agreement (MRA).

Please note that this October, the Ministry of Communications and Information of the Republic of Singapore announced that the Info-communications Development Authority (“**IDA**”), Media Development Authority (“**MDA**”) and the Personal Data Protection Commission (“**PDPC**”) were dissolved and restructured into two new statutory boards, namely the Government Technology Agency (“**GovTech**”) and Info-communications Media Development Authority (“**IMDA**”). As such, the “**IDA**” standards for which you are being recognized are valid until April 2017. After which date, you need to have update your standards to “**IMDA**” standards and have them included in the A2LA Scope of Accreditation. As we understand it, testing labs should have no difficulty updating testing to the IMDA standards as there are no significant changes in the technical requirements. The changes are largely editorial to provide clarity of requirements for conformity assessment, and are in line with developments taken place in the international or regional Standards Development Organizations. Any technical requirement changes are highlighted in the Addendum/Corrigendum of each IMDA Technical Specification.

Also, please note that IMDA has withdrawn the IDA TS RPG, and the IDA TS EMC is no longer valid, superseded by information given in the Explanatory Note on the revised EMC and Safety Framework for ICT Equipment obtainable from this link: <https://www.imda.gov.sg/~media/imda/files/regulation%20licensing%20and%20consultations/licensing/licenses/ida%20technical/ememo%20rev%20emc%20and%20safety%20fw%20for%20ict%2019sep16.pdf?la=en>

As of the date of this letter, **QAI Laboratories, Ltd.** may operate as a recognized testing laboratory with **IMDA** but is contingent upon maintenance of your accreditation status and is limited to the standards listed above.
