A Code Evaluation Report (CER) is a formal report issued by QAI that demonstrates a building product's compliance with applicable sections of the building code, whether your target market is the U.S., Canada, or both.

CERs are particularly useful for products that do not have clearly defined standards or criteria in the code, such as underlayment, weather barriers, sheathing, or insulation systems.

QAI's evaluation process begins with a thorough review of the product's specifications, installation methods, and any existing test data. If additional testing is required, QAI performs it in-house through its accredited construction testing laboratories, which specializes in many different product categories to support fire, physical and mechanical.
